

Report on Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum Collected From Employers

(2022-23)



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Feedback from employers allows them the opportunity to comment on various aspects of curriculum. This provides us with valuable suggestions for further improvement of the curriculum, which can be forwarded to the university through various faculty members who are members of Board of Studies.

Methodology

The feedback from employers on designing and review of curriculum and college infrastructure was obtained through Structured Questionnaire which included 7 questions on various aspects of curriculum and college infrastructure.

A five point Likert scale has been used with weights assigned from 1 to 5 to different levels as follows:

- 1- Below Satisfactory
- 2- Satisfactory
- 3- Good
- 4- Very Good
- 5- Excellent

The Range of each order or level is determined by the following formula:

(Highest point in Likert Scale- Lowest point in Likert Scale)/ Number of Levels Used

Therefore Range= $(5-1)/5=4/5=0.8$

Hence

Range for 'Below Satisfactory' is 1.0 to 1.8

Range for 'Satisfactory' is 1.8 to 2.6

Range for 'Good' is 2.6 to 3.4

Range for 'Very Good' is 3.4 to 4.2

Range for 'Excellent' is 4.2 to 5.0

Data Analysis and Interpretation

Following is the tabular analysis of each question showing number of employers' responses on five point Likert scale, percentage of employers' responses, weighted score and weighted mean score of each question.

Table 1: Responses about college infrastructure.




Figure 1 - Percentage of responses of employers about college infrastructure.

Table 1 reveals that 40% of employers are of the view that the college has excellent infrastructure and very good infrastructure. 20% of the employees are of the view that the college has good infrastructure. The results to Question 1 are presented below in Pie diagram as shown in Figure1.

Here it is also observed that Weighted Mean Score of Question No. 1 is 4.2 which lies between the Likert range of 4.2 to 5.0 i.e. range for 'Excellent'. So, it can be concluded that employers believe that the college has excellent infrastructure.

Table 2 shows reveals that 60 % of employers are of the view that the college has excellent library, 20 % of the employers agrees that the college has very good library and 20 % of the employers agrees that the college has good library. The results to Question 2 are presented below in Pie diagram as shown in Figure 2.




Figure 22 - Percentage of responses of employers about college library.

Here it is also observed that Weighted Mean Score of Question No. 2 is 4.4 which lies between the Likert range of 4.2 to 5.0 i.e. range for 'Excellent'. So, it can be concluded that employers are of the view that the college has excellent library.




Figure 3 - Percentage of responses about facility for internet access.

Table 3 shows that 40 % of employers gave their response that the college has excellent facility for internet access, 40 % of the employers are of the view that the college has very good facility for internet access and 20 % of the employers are of the view that the college has good facility for internet access. The results to Question 3 are presented below in Pie diagram as shown in Figure 3.

Here it is also observed that Weighted Mean Score of Question No. 3 is 4.2 which lies between the Likert range of 4.2 to 5.0 i.e. range for 'Excellent'. So, it can be concluded that employers believe that the college has excellent facility for internet access.




Figure 4 - Percentage of responses about subject knowledge of college students.

The above table 4 shows that 40% of employers are of the view that the college students have excellent subject knowledge, 20 % of the employers are of view that the college students have very good subject knowledge and 40 % of the employers are of view that the college students have good subject knowledge. The results to Question 4 are presented below in Pie diagram as shown in Figure 4.

Here it is also observed that Weighted Mean Score of Question No. 4 is 4.0 which lies between the Likert range of 3.4 to 4.2 i.e. range for 'Very Good'. So, it can be concluded that employers believes that the college students have very good subject knowledge.

Table 5: Responses about communication skills of college students.




Figure 5 - Percentage of responses about communication skills of college students.

The above table 5 shows that 20% of employers are of the view that the college students have excellent communication skills, 60 % of the employers are of view that the college students have very good communication skills and 20 % of the employers are of view that the college students have good communication skills. The results to Question 5 are presented below in Pie diagram as shown in Figure 5.

Here it is also observed that Weighted Mean Score of Question No. 5 is 4.0 which lies between the Likert range of 3.4 to 4.2 i.e. range for 'Very Good'. So, it can be concluded that employers believe that the college students have very good communication skills.

Table 6 : Responses about technical skills of college students.




Figure 6 - Percentage of responses about technical skills of college students.

From table 6 it is clear that 40 % of the employers are of view that the college students have excellent technical skills, 20 % of the employers are of view that the college students have very good technical skills and 40 % of the employers are of view that the college students have good technical skills. The results to Question 6 are presented below in Pie diagram as shown in Figure 6.

Here it is also observed that Weighted Mean Score of Question No. 6 is 4.0 which lies between the Likert range of 3.4 to 4.2 i.e. range for 'Very Good'. So, it can be concluded that employers believe that the college students have very good technical skills.

Table-7: Responses about curriculum as per need of the industry.




Figure 7- Percentage of responses about the curriculum as per need of the industry.

The above table shows that 20 % of employers are of the view that the curriculum is excellent as per the need of the industry, 60 % of the employers are of the view that the curriculum is very good as per the need of the industry and 20 % of the employers are of the view that the curriculum is good as per the need of the industry. The results to Question 7 are presented below in Pie diagram as shown in Figure 7.

Here it is also observed that Weighted Mean Score of Question No. 7 is 4.0 which lies between the Likert range of 3.4 to 4.2 i.e. range for 'Very Good'. So, it can be concluded that employers believe that the curriculum is very good as per the need of the industry.




Figure 8- Weighted Mean Score

Table 8 shows that the average of Weighted Mean Score of all questions related to curriculum is 4.11 which lies between of 3.4 to 4.2 i.e. range for 'Very good'. From which it can be concluded that the employers are of the view that the college have excellent infrastructure, library and internet facility. Employers are also of the view that the college students have very good subject knowledge, technical skills, and communication skills and have very good curriculum which is according to the need of the industry.
