

## HMV organized One Day National Workshop



In second session, she told the students about how to prepare vermicompost at their home. In addition to this various practicals used to test physico-chemical properties of soil like pH, electrical conductivity and water holding capacity of soil etc. were also performed with the help of Ms. Harpreet Kaur. Students took keen interest in these experiments and setting of compost units. Principal Prof. Dr. (Mrs.) Ajay Sareen congratulated the Resource Persons, organizers Mrs. Meenu Kohli and Ms. Shallu Batra.

## HMV convert the waste in to useful products



Hans Raj Mahila Maha Vidyalaya has been doing its bit to reduce trash and convert the waste into useful products. Principal Prof. Dr. (Mrs.) Ajay Sareen told that some of the ventures undertaken to invoke eco-friendly orientation amongst students include: installing waste paper recycling unit, conversion of garbage dumps into green belts around the campus, solid waste management plants, segregation of solid waste, rain water harvesting, grey water reuse, vermicompost preparation, establishing incinerators in wash rooms to reduce sanitary waste among others. Projects like preparation of vermincompost, preparation of bio-pesticides, bio-insecticides, biofuel preparation, preparation of green reducing agents; organic colour preparation and others have been taken up.

Solid Waste Management Plant at the premises of Hans Raj Mahila Maha Vidyalaya is efficiently decomposing solid waste generated by the college will into organic fertilizers. The vermicompost is also prepared in the college from college mess waste and is used in Portable Kitchen Gardens and various edible & ornamental plants will be grown. The waste water from air conditioners etc. is also used for mopping, cleaning purposes. The waste generated in the college boutique

is used to make purses, upcycled dresses and fashionable accessories. The plastic waste is upcycled to make creative decorative pieces. Recycled paper produced in the waste paper recycling unit is transformed into files, folders, envelopes etc. It is worth mentioning that HMV is the only college of Jalandhar to be included in top Swachh Colleges of India. Principal Dr. Ajay Sareen said that recycling is one of the best methods to reduce the waste and contribute to Swachh Bharat Mission.

## HMV Sets example in Water Conservation

Under the able guidance of Principal Prof. Dr. (Mrs.) Ajay Sareen, Hans Raj Mahila Maha Vidyalaya has taken steady strides for conservation, reuse and recycling of water. Significant steps have been taken over the years for water management. A number of innovative strategies for groundwater augmentation have been devised including establishment of ten rain harvesting units at different locates in the college premises for recharging the water table. The rain water harvesting units are modeled after Seechewal model of rain water harvesting. As the nation is suffering from recurring water shortage issues, proper water management is the need of the hour. HMV being conscious of its environmental responsibility has adopted a multipronged strategy to conserve water. Grey water from wash rooms is stored and reused for gardening, cleaning, washing, laundry etc. Special tank placements, plumbing mechanisms have been done to recycle and reuse water which led to saving a tremendous amount of water. Waste water from Ac's is also reused for mopping. Regular awareness activities for water awareness are carried out in the college like celebrations & World Water Day, Water Pledge etc. Innovative plantations are done to save waer. On the occasion of World Water Day, Prinicpal Prof. Dr.

(Mrs.) Ajay Sareen reinforced the need of water conservation. Dr. Anjana Bhatia, Dean Innovations and Research gave an awareness lecture to supporting staff for reuse of water in the campus.





## **One Day Educational Visit to National Institute of Renewable Energy, Kapurthala**

Chandrayaan Vipnet Club of PG Department of Physics of Hans Raj Mahila Maha Vidyalaya, Jalandhar organized a one day educational visit under the guidance of Principal Prof. Dr. Ajay Sareen. A team of 48 students accompanied by two teachers. Students visited four research laboratories operational on synthesis, characterization and testing of biofuels Bioenergy and synthetic fuels in solid, liquid and gaseous forms for transportation, portable and stationary applications as well as Development of hybrid/integrated energy systems based on solar energy and wind energy. They learnt about the various processes for production of Bio-fuel in chemical conversion R&D Lab and BioChemical conversion of R&D Lab, Designing, testing experimental efficiency of different models of Cook Stoves developed at NIRE and improving biomass Cook stove. In the hybrid/integrated energy systems labs, students learnt about working of solar panels for conversion of solar energy to electricity and various control factors for improving the output of solar panels. They also learnt about the application of Solar Panels for heating water in Solar Water heaters/Geysers. Students also saw the working model of Wind Mill, learnt about finding the threshold speed of wind required for converting wind energy to electricity. The visit was very informative and students were motivated to undertake research as a career and utilize their knowledge for betterment of Society.
