The wall was inaugurated by Sh. Avtar Singh Junior (Bawa Henry), MLA, Sh. Mohinder Singh Gullu, Councillor and Sh. Manbir Singh.
- In order to add another initiative to Swachh Bharat Campaign, Plastic Bottle Crusher Machine was installed in the campus in collaboration with Municipal Corporation Jalandhar on 5 Jan, 2021.
- HMV is whole heartedly participating in My Waste My Responsibility campaign of Municipal Corporation, Jalandhar. The waste water from air conditioners is used for mopping and cleaning purposes. The waste generated in the college boutique is used to make purses, upcycled dresses and fashionable accessories. The plastic waste is upcycled to make creative decorative pieces. Recycled paper produced in the waste paper recycling unit is transformed into files, folders, envelopes etc.
- Principal Prof. Dr. (Mrs.) Ajay Sareen, in yet another innovative venture, carried out the plantation of Parijat tree near the Yajnasala in the premises of Hans Raj Mahila Maha Vidyalaya. Jalandhar on 27 October, 2020. Parijat tree, also called the Kalpavriksh was planted along with a traditional unglazed Matka filled with water for drip irrigation.
- Hans Raj Mahila Maha Vidyalaya has taken steady strides for conservation, reuse and recycling of water. A number of innovative strategies for groundwater augmentation have been devised including establishment of ten rain harvesting units at different locates in the college premises. The rain water harvesting units are modeled after Seechewal model of rain water harvesting. HMV being conscious of its environmental responsibility has adopted a multipronged strategy to conserve water. Greywater from wash rooms is stored and reused for gardening, cleaning, washing, laundry etc. Special tank placements, plumbing mechanisms have been done to recycle and reuse water which led to saving a tremendous amount of water.
