

CURRENT HIGHLIGHTS OF THE INSTITUTION

I deem it my pleasure to share the glorious achievements of this great institution which has a long saga of rich moral values and endless perseverance to reach the undefined contours of success. **Hans Raj Mahila Maha Vidyalaya, Jalandhar**, a prestigious, multi-faculty institution of India, was established in 1927 at Lahore with the pious efforts of Mahatma Hans Raj Ji, a pioneer of DAV movement, and re-established in March, 1948 at Arya Samaj, Bikrampura, Jalandhar. Sarvpalli Dr. Radhakrishnan, the then Vice President of India inaugurated the present campus on 7th Nov., 1959. Madam Vidyawati Anand, the founder Principal of the college left no stone unturned to create a conducive environment. Since then persistent and sincere efforts have been made to achieve a mark of excellence in the field of academics, sports, co-curricular activities, research projects, publications etc.

Status of College of Excellence – a rare achievement

The University Grants Commission, New Delhi has granted the status of 'College of Excellence' to Hans Raj Mahila Maha Vidyalaya for a period of five years. It is the first college amongst all the colleges of Punjab, Haryana, Himachal, J&K, Bihar, Chandigarh and Delhi to get this status.



Status of Star College

The college has received DBT Star College Status under which the Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India has granted the above status as well as monetary grant to Science Departments i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany.

Highest score in the country

It was the first college in India to be awarded the maximum score of 3.83 during re-accreditation by NAAC in 2012. Earlier, it was the first college in India to get the highest score 94.05 in 2004.

B.Voc. & Community College – a new enterprise

B.Vocational in **Web Technology** and **Banking & Financial Services** and **Community College** have been started this year. It is a matter of pride that HVM is the **only college** of GNDU to start both these courses. Under Community College, HVM has started **Advance Diploma in Fashion Designing** with the grant of **Rs.74.00 lacs** for two years.



International Conference

An **International Conference on “Future and Challenges of Computational and Integrated Sciences”** was organized on 7th and 8th Nov., 2014 by PG Departments of Computer Science and Bioinformatics.

INSPIRE Programme

The college organized **DST INSPIRE SCIENCE INTERNSHIP CAMP** from **January 6- 10, 2015** in the college premises. A grant of **Rs. 13,00,000/-** was received from the Department of Science and Technology to nurture **200 participants** during this **5 day residential programme**

Innovative courses introduced

With a strength of approx. 5500 students, the institution offers **11 PG programmes, 4 PG Diplomas, 7 UG programmes** in **Science** stream, **2 UG programmes** in **Comp.Sc. and IT**, **3 UG 4 year Degree programmes, 3 UG programmes** in **Commerce**, **24 subjects** in **B.A.** including **vocational subjects** and **7 UG Honours programmes** and **13 Add-on-courses**. A blend of tradition and modernity has always been our vision. Keeping in mind the global scenario, innovative employment oriented subjects/courses like Web Technology, Bachelor of Design, Bachelor of Fine Arts, M.Sc. Fashion Dsg., Banking and Financial Services, Multimedia, add-on-course in Reporting, Anchoring and News Reading and Communication Skills have been introduced in addition to the existing traditional basic courses in Science, Commerce and Humanities. The college aims at translating its vision **Women's Education; Nation's March towards Globalization** into reality.

Upgradation of infrastructure

In tune with the current times, the infrastructure has been upgraded with an **Indoor Stadium** for sportswomen, a **Swimming Pool** for fitness, an air conditioned new **Hostel**, a new **Mess**, a new **Bioinformatics Lab**, a new **Physics Lab** and a new **Chemistry Lab**. The **Botanical Garden** has also been reoriented and given a facelift.

Centre for Gandhian Studies

Centre for Gandhian Studies has been established under the UGC Scheme '**EPOCH Making Social Thinkers of India**'. An exclusive Book Section has been established in the main Library for Gandhian Studies. Books have been purchased for Rs.50,000/- for this section. The centre is also imparting vocational training for the underprivileged women and more than 20 women presently are under the training programme.

The college organized an **International Conference**, a **National Conference**, **6 Seminars**, **28 workshops** and **8 Extension lectures** to keep the staff and students updated in their respective fields.

26 papers were presented by the staff members in International Conferences/Seminars/Workshops, **64 papers** were presented by the staff members in National Conferences/Seminars/Workshops and **19 National Conferences/Seminars/Workshops** were attended by staff members from time to time.

OUR BRILLIANT RESULTS 2013-2014

Our students proved their mettle in the final university examinations in various courses.

- The institution bagged **16 First positions, 21 Second positions** and **19 Third positions** in GNDU in **Semester I and III Exams.** held in Dec., 2013. The students appeared in 44 different courses. The college results were 100% with **1114 First Divisions** and **62 merit positions.**
- The institution bagged **26 First positions, 24 Second positions** and **11 Third positions** in GNDU in **Semester II and IV Exams.** held in May, 2014. The college results were 100% in 34 courses with **1456 First Divisions** and **82 merit positions** and **23 distinctions.**
- In **Annual Exam.** held in April, 2014, the college bagged **4 First positions, 4 Second positions** and **5 Third positions** and **100% result** in **9 classes** with **487 First Divisions** and **24 merit positions.**

CAMPUS BUZZ








VALUE EDUCATION
