Webinar on Unique ways to Physics



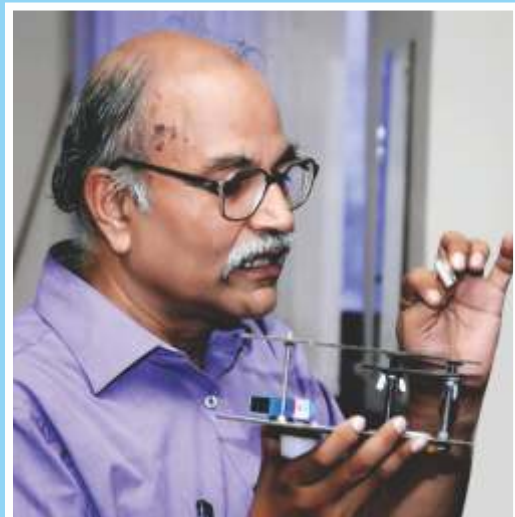

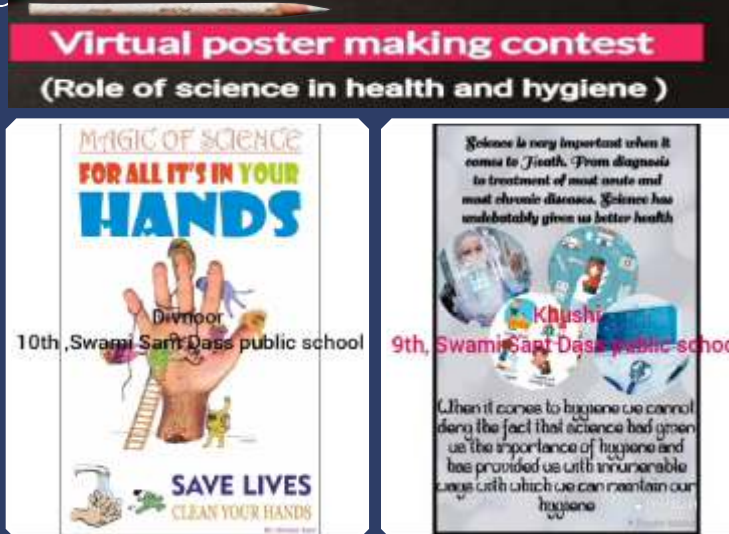
Glimpses of Pratibha Khoj
